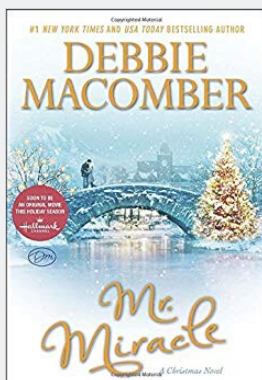
Ms Ann then led the children in games and served refreshments.
