**Crazy Stupid Bromance** by Lyssa Kay Adams- A hacktivist and a cat café owner decode the friend zone in this romantic comedy from the author of *Undercover Bromance*. Alexis Carlisle and her cat café, ToeBeans, have shot to fame after she came forward as a victim of a celebrity chef's sexual harassment. When a new customer approaches to confide in her, the last thing Alexis expects is for the woman to claim they're sisters. Unsure what to do, Alexis turns to the only man she trusts—her best friend, Noah Logan.

**A Time for Mercy** by John Grisham- Jake Brigance, the protagonist of *A Time to Kill*, John Grisham's classic legal thriller is back. This time he's at the epicenter of a sensational murder trial that bitterly divides the citizens of Clanton, Mississippi. Jake is the court-appointed lawyer for Drew Gamble, a young man accused of murdering a local deputy. Many in Clanton want a swift trial and the death penalty, but Brigance sees it another way. Once he learns the details of the case, he realizes he has to do everything he can to save Drew—who is sixteen. Jake's commitment to the truth puts his career and the safety of his family at risk.
